

Hope for Justice is a global charity with a goal to end modern slavery. We help identify victims of human trafficking and modern slavery, advocate on their behalf, and aid the process of overcoming trauma and rebuilding their lives.

We also raise awareness and influence policymakers to improve legislation, and assist businesses to protect their operations and supply chains from modern slavery.

## Hope for Justice: North West Hub

The Hub team works to prevent exploitation and to identify modern slavery in Lancashire and across the North West via training, partnership and community engagement.

We work together with homelessness charities, food banks, local councils, the police and other community services to identify modern slavery, and to help survivors access support. This includes:

- Meeting with people who may have experienced modern slavery to offer independent guidance on their situation, explaining their options such as entering safe house support and reporting to the police.
- Assisting frontline staff with pre-NRM (National Referral Mechanism) support such as screening questions for modern slavery, writing NRM referrals, seeking legal advice and advocating for housing.
- Helping with engagement, support and advocacy of vulnerable people at risk of exploitation.
- · Offering signposting and support for any other needs identified.

We also raise awareness of modern slavery among communities who may be targets for exploitation through our outreach work.

## **Bespoke Training**

Our North West Hub also currently offers bespoke, fully funded training to people and services who support or may come into contact with potential victims and survivors of modern slavery.

We believe that by equipping people who are specialists in their own field with relevant, comprehensive and practical guidance, we can increase the number of victims identified and improve the response and help offered by services.

Our Modern Slavery Training is particularly relevant for anyone involved in policing and law enforcement, government, healthcare and social work and non-governmental work in the community, such as food banks, drop-in centres, community groups, outreach and those working with vulnerable people.

We offer short basic awareness training as well as longer, in-depth courses on modern slavery for practitioners and professionals. Our skills-based training on trauma-informed case reporting, and trauma-informed listening ensures an appropriate and professional response.
